## PALM SUNDAY *24th March*

This performance begins at 7.00 pm at the fountain (Plaza España), continues in the direction of Paseo de las Palmeras and ends at the Church of San Marcos in Plaza de la Constitución.

At the fountain, Jesus will meet the Samaritan woman, just minutes before the scene of Jesús' miracles begins. Jesus will heal a blind man, cure an epileptic man, and save an adulterous woman from being stoned to death. After this, Jesus will cross el Paseo de las Palmeras to reach the church of San Marcos. There, Jesus will show his anger upon finding the temple, his Father's house, turned into a marketplace.



## MAUNDY THURSDAY *28th March*

It begins at 10.00 pm at the church of San Marcos (Plaza de la Constitución), continues in the direction of the fountain (Plaza España) and ends at the church of San Marcos in Plaza de la Constitución.

The performance begins with the Last Supper, where Jesus shares bread and wine with his disciples. During this meal, Jesus washes the feet of his disciples as an act of humility and service. He also predicts that he will die and that one of his disciples will betray him.

After the last Supper, the representation moves towards the fountain, where the "Olive Garden" takes place. At this moment, an angel appears to Jesus. Then, Judas arrives and betrays Jesus with a kiss, leading to Jesus' arrest.

Finally, this performance concludes at the Town Hall (Plaza del Ayuntamiento), where we can witness the trial before Caifás, the Sanhedrin who accuses Jesus and requests that he be taken to Pilate to be sentenced to death.

## GOOD FRIDAY *29th March*

It begins at 12:00 pm at the church of San Marcos (Plaza de la Constitución), continues at Angel Matos street, and Virgen de Gracia avenue, and ends at Sanctuary of Virgen de Gracia.

The performance starts with Pilate's trial, where Jesus is whipped and sentenced to death. This continues at the fountain (Plaza España), where Jesus is mocked and scorned by King Herodes. After this, "El camino de los calvarios" takes place, representing Jesus' three falls along the mentioned streets until reaching Sanctuary of Virgen de Gracia, where his crucifixion and death are acted out.



## EASTER SUNDAY *31st March*

It begins at 11.00 pm at Sanctuary of Virgen de Gracia.

The scene begins with an angel removing the stone from Jesus' tomb, and the women in black, who discover that the tomb is empty. The angel tells these women that Jesus has risen, and they rush to tell the disciples. Next, Mary Magdalene, Saint Peter, and Saint John appear, and the latter says that Jesús had already announced that he would rise again. Finally, Jesus appears and asks the disciples to share the gospel.
